


DID YOU KNOW?

Chapter House Board members serve a term of four (4) years. Sequencing of appointments is annual, with three (3) new members replacing three (3) retiring members.*

At the March meeting of the CH board, applications shall be submitted to the Idaho State Executive Board for consideration. New terms of office begin in July.

The application process for the CH board includes a personal letter from the applicant and a letter of recommendation from the applicant's chapter president.

*No member shall be appointed for two consecutive terms. However, a member who is appointed as a replacement may be appointed, if willing to serve, to a full four year term following the completion of the partial term served. Chapters may have only one member serving on the board at one time.
