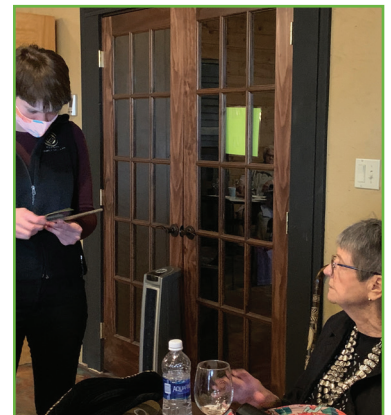
RESIDENTS COUNCIL
